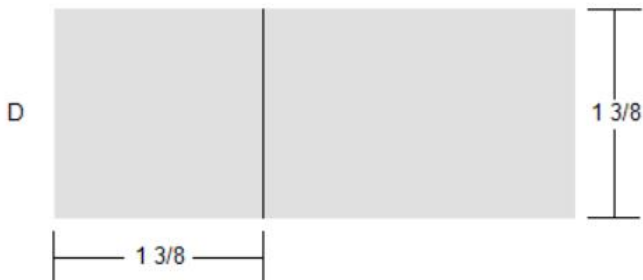
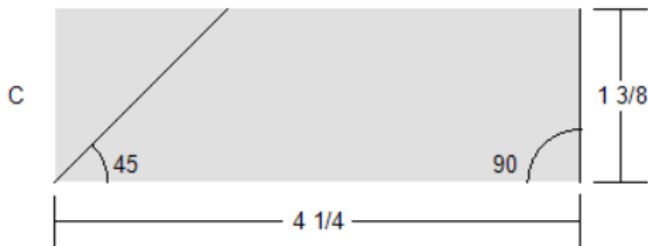
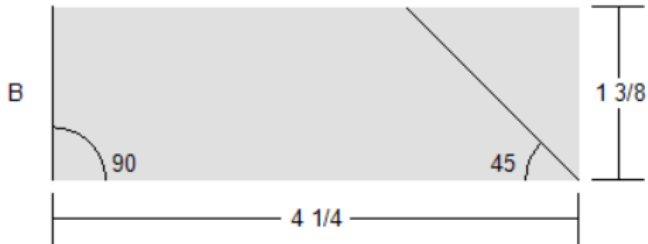
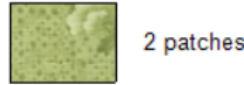
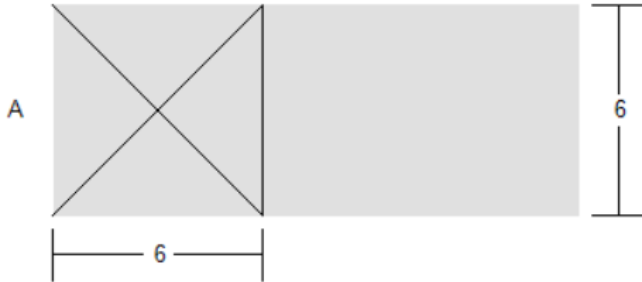
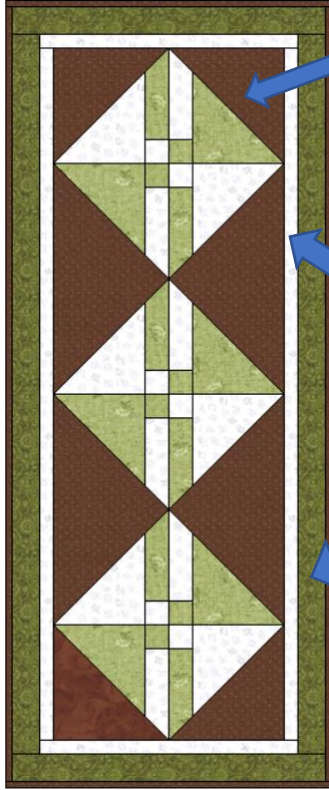


Cutting Diagrams

Patch Count





Cut **BROWN** squares 6" x 6" and then cut them on the diagonal forming triangles.

You will need a total of 12 triangles. Sew the brown triangles on the quilt blocks as shown. Trim up as described in the video.

Cut 2 white border strips 1" wide x the length of your wall hanging.





Sew the white border strips onto each of the long sides of your hanging.

Cut 2 white border strips 1" wide x the width of your wall hanging (including the newly added white side border strips). Sew them to the top and the bottom.

Cut 2 green border strips 1 ½" x the length of your wall hanging (AFTER sewing on the white borders). Sew one green border strip on each long side.

Cut 2 green border strips 1 ½ " x the width of your wall hanging (Including the newly added green side borders). Sew them to the top and the bottom.

According to the EQ7 Instructions, here is what you will need for fabric. Since I just used scraps that I had on hand and didn't measure anything, I cannot vouch for this BUT if anything, EQ would ere on the side of telling you to buy a bit too much fabric and heavens knows we do like to add to our "fabric collections". 😊
